RE: Fragrance Oil Burner instructions

Fragrance Oil Burner instructions:

Please refer to the below instructions, which is required to be enclosed inside each package of oil burners:

WARNING: Oil burners are potentially dangerous if used incorrectly. Read and follow the instructions below carefully before each use. Keep for future reference.

1. Remove all packaging and labels before use and make sure oil burner is placed on a level, heat and flame-resistant surface.
2. Keep out of reach of children and pets. Keep away from draughts and flammable materials and clear of matches and other debris.
3. Fill the top bowl of the burner $\frac{3}{4}$ full with your choice of Hobby Lobby Fragrance Oils. Be sure not to overfill bowl.
4. Place one unscented, unlit tealight in the base of the burner and light carefully with a match or splint. Fragranced tealights can cause overheating.
5. Check the amount of oil in the bowl periodically. **Never allow vaporizer bowl to burn dry.** You may add additional oil as long as there is still oil in the bowl. If no oil remains, extinguish flame immediately and allow burner to cool before refilling to $\frac{3}{4}$ full.
6. Use only metal cased tealights and do not burn candle for more than 2 hours at a time.
7. Do not allow oils to come in contact with finished surfaces as this may cause damage.
8. Do not mix oils.
9. Oils should not be taken internally. Avoid contact with skin.
7. Clean bowl regularly by wiping bowl with a clean dry cloth. If needed, hand wash with a mild detergent and wipe dry. Always start burning process with a clean dry bowl.
8. **Burners can be HOT! Do not touch or move oil burner during use.** After candle is extinguished, let burner cool before touching or handling.
9. Extinguish immediately if the flame becomes enlarged or smokes excessively.
- 10. Never leave burning candle unattended.**
11. Do not use perfume oils intended for skin as they can be flammable.
12. Never allow oils to come in contact with candle flame.
